Display area

Entrants must provide their own displays. This is an outdoor show. Displays must be sturdy and able to withstand weather and crowds. Each entrant is responsible for keeping their space clean and safe. On-site security will be provided Friday and Saturday nights.

Please note: The Festival Committee and its sponsors will not be liable for any loss or damage to entrant's displays or contents.

Set-up

Set up times: Friday, December 2nd noon - 5 p.m. and Saturday, December 3rd, 8 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. All displays must be ready when the gates open at 10:00 a.m. each morning. Vehicles must be in the Vendor Parking area no later than 9:45 a.m. **Displays must not be removed until the close of the Festival on Sunday, December 4.**

Fees

Heritage Village demonstration space is free of charge if no sales are conducted. (If also selling product, fill out non-food vendor application with associated fees.) Each vendor will receive a maximum of 3 passes. Any other helpers must pay to enter Festival.
